- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range, or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.

Failure to follow all safety precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death.

Introduction

This publication has instructions for using the MPSMW9-EXP19MIR Mounting Kit to mount a MicroPulse MPSW9 light head to each side mirror of the Ford Expedition.

NOTE: For electrical installation instructions, refer to the Installation and Maintenance Instructions packed with the light head.

Unpacking the Kit

After unpacking the kit, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If it has been damaged, do not attempt to install or operate it. File a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of the damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels, and tags before removing or destroying them. Ensure that the parts in Table 1 are included in the package. If you are missing any parts, contact Customer Support at 1-800-264-3578, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (CT).


NOTICE

DRILLING PRECAUTION: When drilling holes, check the area you are drilling into to be sure you do not damage vehicle components. All drilled holes should be deburred, and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wire routings going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split loom tubing.

To install the light:

1. Position and align bracket (8861304461 PS/DS) to the contour of the mirror as seen in Figure 2. Mark the mounting holes and a wire access hole.

- 2. Drill three 5/32-inch mounting holes, plus a hole for wire routing.
- 3. Prepare the wiring.
- **4.** Install the bracket with the three #10 Type B six-lobe screws.

- 5. Install the MPSW9 with the provided 6-32 nuts and screws.
- **6.** Repeat the previous steps on the other side of the vehicle.
- 7. Complete the wiring per the instructions supplied with the light head.

- **8.** Test the lights for proper operation.
- **9.** Reassemble the front of the vehicle according to the manufacturer's service manual.
