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Safety Message to Installers

A WARNING

People's lives depend on your proper installation of our products. It is important to read, understand and follow all instructions shipped with the products. Listed below are some other important safety instructions and precautions you should follow:

- To properly install this light, you must have a good understanding of automotive electrical procedures and systems, along with proficiency in the installation and use of safety warning equipment.
- DO NOT install equipment or route wiring or cord in the deployment path of an airbag.
- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, be sure that both sides
 of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Locate the light control so the VEHICLE and CONTROL can be operated safely under all driving conditions.
- Do not attempt to activate or deactivate light control while driving in a hazardous situation.
- This product contains high intensity LED devices. To prevent eye damage, DO NOT stare into the light beam at close range.
- Frequently inspect the light to ensure that it is operating properly and that it is securely attached to the vehicle.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.

Failure to follow all safety precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death to you or others.

Overview of the QuadraFlare

The Federal Signal QuadraFlare Warning Light is a self-contained, high intensity, LED light designed for mounting to the exterior of a vehicle. All models are available in a variety of colors and have an internal flasher. The internal flasher has 26 selectable flash patterns. All units are designed to work with Federal Signal flashers. However, before they can operate with a Federal Signal flasher, put internal flashers into pattern 20 or 21. Refer to the particular flasher instructions for proper wiring. Additionally, all units have a Dim Mode (low power) that allows the user to reduce the light brightness for nighttime use. The QuadraFlare Warning Light is designed for operation on 12 Vdc at 2.0 A. The models can have one side switched off while the opposite side continues to operate.

NOTE: All units should NOT be considered for steady burn applications.

Unpacking the QuadraFlare

After unpacking the light, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If the unit has been damaged, file a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels, and tags before removing or destroying them. If installing a permanent mounted beacon, ensure that the parts listed in Table 1 are included in the package.

Installing the QuadraFlare

A WARNING

INSTALL IN RECOMMENDED AREAS: When installing equipment inside airbag equipped vehicles, the installer MUST ensure that the equipment is installed ONLY in areas recommended by the vehicle manufacturer.




Figure 1 Mounting hole locations

NOTE: For maximum coverage and effectiveness, mount the light assembly in a horizontal orientation. See Figure 1.

Before proceeding with installation, determine the approximate location of the light assembly and plan all cable/wire routing.

To install the QuadraFlare:

1. Position the QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly on the desired mounting surface. Ensure that the unit is level side to side. Using the dimensions provided in Figure 1, scribe the four mounting hole locations and a wiring routing hole location on the mounting surface.

NOTICE

DAMAGE TO LIGHT: When installing the QuadraFlare light on a vehicle, you MUST use the manufacturer's supplied screws and screw grommets. Do not use an impact drill or an electric screw gun when installing the light. Torque the mounting screws to the manufacturer's recommended specification of 12 in-lb +/-10 percent.

Installing the QuadraFlare

Failure to observe these precautions damages the light and void any warranty claims for the light.

NOTICE


DRILLING PRECAUTIONS: When drilling holes, check the area you are drilling into to ensure that you do not damage vehicle components while drilling. All drilled holes should be de-burred, and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wire routings going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split loom tubing.

- **2.** Drill four 1/4-inch mounting holes and a one-inch wire routing hole at the previously scribed locations.
- 3. Install the four supplied rubber rivet nuts into the four 1/4-inch mounting holes.

NOTE: When removing the QuadraFlare Warning Lights, inspect the mounting grommets for wear and replace them as needed.

- **4.** The QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly has five 12-inch long lead wires, which exit out the back of the unit, for making electrical connections.
- **5.** Complete the electrical connections as described in the Electrical Connections section.
- **6.** Align the QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly with the previously inserted rubber rivet nuts and secure with the provided #6 by 2-inch screws. See Figure 2.

Figure 2 Exploded Assembly View



NOTE: QuadraFlare models have identifiable color-coded sticker dots on the back of the light assembly. The color-coded sticker dots correspond to the LED color on the PC board. Note these dots prior to any final assembly mounting to obtain proper light assembly orientation. See Figure 3.

Selecting a Flash Pattern

Looking at the back of the unit with the vent hole on your right, the top of the light is controlled with the red wire and the bottom is controlled with the white wire. See Figure 3. If the light has one side with red LEDs, the red wire controls that side and the white controls the other side (amber, blue, white, green, or red).

Wiring the QuadraFlare

The Model QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly operates on 12 Vdc. Five 12-inch long lead wires are supplied for making electrical connections to the QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly. Ensure that all wires are properly connected and insulated appropriately.

To make electrical connections:

- 1. Using 18 AWG (minimum) wire, connect the red (+) lead to the positive power source terminal and the black (–) lead to the negative power source terminal.
- 2. On the QuadraFlare, connect the white (+) lead to the same positive power source terminal as the red (+) lead to operate or switch to power up independently of each other.
- **3.** On all models, the violet wire (low power, dimming) is connected to +12 V power source. Removing the power restores the unit back to full power.
- **4.** Apply power and test the QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly for proper operation.

Selecting a Flash Pattern

The QuadraFlare has 26 selectable flash patterns with Pattern 1 as the default. See Table 2 for a description of each pattern and the order in which it is stored in memory.

To select flash patterns:

- 1. Remove and retain the four #6 by 2-inch. mounting screws.
- **2.** Apply power to the light.

3. Briefly touch the program wire (yellow) to +12 Vdc.

NOTE: Holding the pattern wire (yellow) to +12 Vdc for 5 to 9 seconds returns you to default flash pattern 1. Holding the pattern wire (yellow) to +12 Vdc for 10 seconds or more brings you to default flash pattern 2.

- **4.** When the pattern you want displays, let it run for 15 seconds to store it in memory.
- **5.** Secure the entire QuadraFlare Warning Light assembly to the mounting surface with the previously retained screws.

Cleaning the QuadraFlare

A WARNING

CRAZING/CRACKING Crazing (fine cracks) of lenses causes reduced effectiveness of the light. Do not use cleaning agents (which cause crazing) such as strong detergents, solvents, or petroleum products. If crazing of the lenses does occur, the reliability of light for emergency signaling purposes may be reduced until the lenses are replaced.

NOTICE

CLEANING the POLYCARBONATE LENSES: To extend the life of this device, periodic cleaning is necessary. Clean the lens with a mild, non-abrasive, neutral-pH cleaning agent and a soft, clean cloth. Rinse the device thoroughly to ensure that no cleaning agent residue remains. To avoid water spots, dry the device with a soft clean cloth. Failure to follow this precaution can cause crazing or cracking of the lens/dome and voids the warranty claims for the light.

Scratched or dull reflector, mirrors or lenses reduce the effectiveness of the lighting system. Use a mild, non-abrasive, neutral-pH cleaning agent and a soft, clean cloth, when cleaning the lighting system. Replace any optical components that may have been scratched or crazed during system installation. The use of strong, non-neutral-pH cleaners voids the warranty.
