- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- You should frequently inspect the light to ensure that it is operating properly and that it is securely attached to the visor.
- Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, be sure that both sides of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.

### **Introduction**

This publication has instructions for using the XSMBKT03 Headliner Mount to mount single- and dual-head XStream<sup>™</sup> models.

**NOTE:** For electrical installation instructions, refer to the Installation and Maintenance Instructions packed with the lighthouse.

## Installation Instructions

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### Unpacking the Kit

After unpacking the kit, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If it has been damaged, do not attempt to install or operate it. File a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels, and tags before removing or destroying them. Ensure that the parts in the Kit Contents list are included in the package. If you are missing any parts, contact Customer Support at 1-800-264-3578, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (CT).

### Installing the Brackets

#### **WARNING**

**AIRBAG DEPLOYMENT:** *Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag. Failure to observe this warning will reduce the effectiveness of the airbag or potentially dislodge the equipment, causing serious injury or death.*

**NOTE:** Plan all cable routing before the installation.

**DRILLING PRECAUTIONS:** *When drilling holes, check the area you are drilling into to be sure you do not damage vehicle components. All drilled holes should be deburred and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wire routings going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split loom tubing.*

#### **NOTICE**

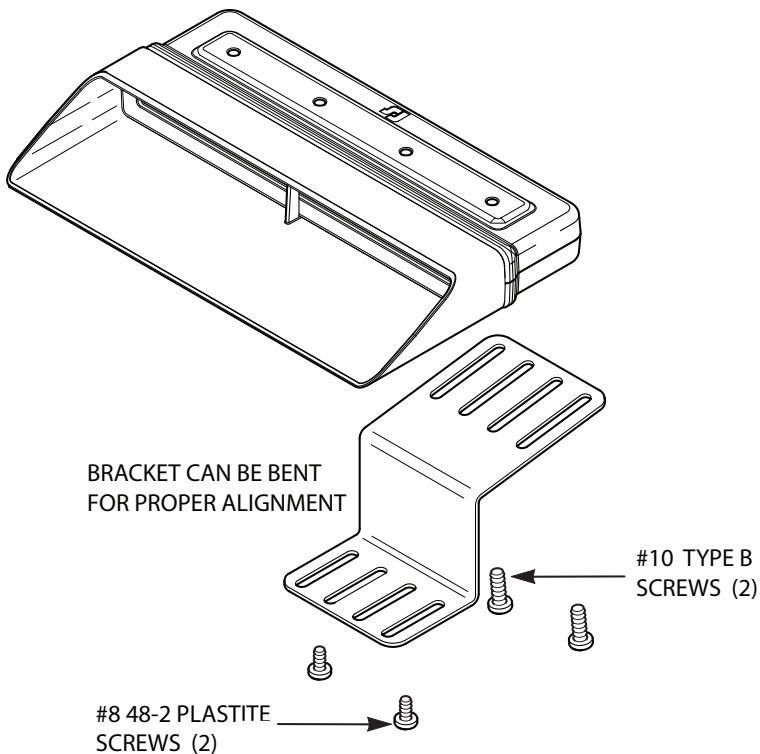
**THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING:** *To prevent thread damage and galling, anti-seize lubricant must be used on all stainless steel fasteners.*

To install the brackets:

1. Attach the headliner bracket to the XStream lighthead using the two supplied #8 screws. Do not overtighten them.

2. Place the XStream lighthead into the selected mounting location. The bracket can be bent for proper alignment. Mark the location of two mounting holes.
3. Drill two 0.159 in holes (#21 drill).
4. Secure the XStream lighthead using the two supplied #10 pan-head screws.
5. Complete the wiring according to the instructions supplied with the lighthead.

4. Test the lights for proper operation.
