Safety Messages to Installers of Warning Light Equipment

A WARNING

People's lives depend on your safe installation of our products. It is important to read, understand and follow all instructions shipped with the products. Listed below are some other important safety instructions and precautions you should follow.

- To properly install this light, you must have a good understanding of automotive electrical procedures and systems, along with proficiency in the installation and use of safety warning equipment.
- DO NOT install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag.
- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- Frequently inspect the light to ensure that it is operating properly and is securely attached to the vehicle.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, ensure that both sides of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.
- Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range, or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.

Failure to follow all safety precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death.

Introduction

This publication has instructions for using the XSMBKT02 Adjustable Swivel Mount to mount single- and dual-head XStream models.

NOTE: For electrical installation instructions, refer to the Installation and Maintenance Instructions packed with the light head.

Unpacking the Kit

After unpacking the kit, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If it has been damaged, do not attempt to install or operate it. File a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels, and tags before removing or destroying them. Ensure that the parts in the Kit Contents list are included in the package. If you are missing any parts, contact Customer Support at 1-800-264-3578, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (CT).

Installing the Brackets

▲ WARNING

AIRBAG DEPLOYMENT: Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag. Failure to observe this warning will reduce the effectiveness of the airbag or potentially dislodge the equipment, causing serious injury or death.

NOTE: Plan all cable routing before the installation.


NOTICE

THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING: To prevent thread damage and galling, use anti-seize lubricant on all stainless steel fasteners.

To install the brackets:

1. Attach the side-mount bracket assembly to the XStream light module using the two supplied #8 screws. Do not overtighten the screws. See Figure 1.

- 2. Loosely assemble the two side-mount brackets to the two side-mount attachment bracket assemblies using the two supplied internal-tooth lockwashers and Keps® nuts. Do not overtighten the nuts.
- **3.** Position the assembly in the desired location and mark the four mounting holes.

▲ WARNING

DRILLING PRECAUTIONS: When drilling holes, check the area you are drilling into to ensure that you do not damage vehicle components while drilling. All drilled holes should be deburred, and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wire routings going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split loom tubing.

- 4. Drill four 0.159-inch holes (#21 drill).
- **5.** Install the XStream light fixture into desired vehicle location using the four supplied #10 pan-head screws.
- **6.** Adjust the light head to the desired angle and tighten the two nuts. Do not overtighten.
- **7.** Complete the wiring according to the instructions supplied with the light head.

▲ WARNING

LIGHT HAZARD: To be an effective warning device, an emergency warning system produces bright light that can be hazardous to your eyesight when viewed at a close range. Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range, or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.

8. Test the lights for proper operation.
