INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR MODEL 454218 HIGHLIGHTER™ FLAT MOUNTING BRACKETS

I. GENERAL.

The Model 454218 mounting bracket enables a Highlighter Solaris LED to be mounted to flat surfaces where access to the mounting location from beneath is difficult.

II. UNPACKING.

After unpacking the kit, carefully check that the parts shown in the kit contents list are contained in the packing bag.

IV. INSTALLATION.

A. Determine the mounting location for the light.

B. Attach each of the brackets to the bottom of the Highlighter as shown in figure 1. Use the hardware supplied with the Highlighter

C. Using the lightbar with brackets installed as a template, mark 4 locations for the mounting holes. The pattern will be 12.05" X 9".

D. Select installer supplied hardware appropriate for the particular installation. The holes in the bracket are .280" diameter. Drill two holes sized for the selected hardware at the marked locations.

E. Secure the lightbar to the mounting surface using the installer supplied mounting hardware.

F. Continue installing the lightbar according to its included instruction sheet.

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
