Safety Message to Installers of Warning Light Equipment

A WARNING

People's lives depend on your proper installation and servicing of Federal Signal products. It is important to read and follow all instructions shipped with this product and the original product. In addition, listed below are some other important safety instructions and precautions you should follow:

- To properly install the lighting system, you must have a good understanding of automotive systems, along with proficiency in the installation and use of safety warning equipment.
- Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag.
- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, be sure that both sides of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.
- You should frequently inspect the light system to ensure that it is operating properly and that it is securely attached to the vehicle.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.

Failure to follow all precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death.

Introduction

This publication has instructions for using the MPSMW9-TAH15MIR Mounting Kit to mount a MicroPulse Model MPSW9 lighthead to each side-mirror on the 2015 Chevy Tahoe.

NOTE: For electrical installation instructions, refer to the installation instructions included with the lights.

Unpacking the Kit

After unpacking the kit, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If it has been damaged, do not attempt to install or operate it. File a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels, and tags before removing or destroying them. Disposal of all shipping materials must be carried out in accordance with national and local codes and standards. Ensure that the parts listed in the Kit Contents List are included in the package. If you are missing any parts, contact Customer Support at 1-800-264-3578, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (CT).

Preparing the Mounting Surface

A WARNING


NOTICE

DRILLING PRECAUTIONS: Before drilling holes, check the area into which you plan to drill to ensure you do not damage vehicle components while drilling. All drilled holes should be de-burred and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wires going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split-loom tubing.

To prepare the mounting surface:

- 1. Remove the side-mirror access covers.
- **2.** Position the appropriate bracket on an access cover as shown in Figure 1.
- **3.** Using the bracket as a template, mark the three mounting holes on the access cover.

- **4.** Drill a 5/32 in (0.156 in) mounting hole at each of the three marks.
- **5.** Mark and drill a wire-routing hole in the access covers for the lightheads. Smooth and deburr the hole.
- **6.** Repeat Steps 2 through 5 for the other access cover.

Securing the Lightheads to the Side Mirrors

To secure the lightheads and complete the installation:

- 1. Secure each bracket to an access cover with the three #10 Type B screws.
- **2.** Feed the wires from the lightheads through the wire-routing holes in the brackets.
- **3.** Feed the wires through the wire-routing holes in the access covers.
- **4.** Secure the lightheads to the brackets with the 6-32 nuts and Phillips screws.
- **5.** Reinstall the access covers.
- **6.** Complete the wiring as described in the instructions supplied with the lightheads.

7. Test the lights for proper operation.

- Any estimate required.

When you receive your RMA Number:

- Write the RMA number on the outside of the box of returned items.
- Reference the RMA number on your paperwork inside of the box.
- Write the RMA number down, so that you can easily check on status of the returned equipment.
