# Safety Message to Installers of Warning Light Equipment

#### **A**WARNING

People's lives depend on your proper installation and servicing of Federal Signal products. It is important to read and follow all instructions shipped with this product and the original product. In addition, listed below are some other important safety instructions and precautions you should follow:

- To properly install the lighting system, you must have a good understanding of automotive systems, along with proficiency in the installation and use of safety warning equipment.
- Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment path of an airbag.
- If a vehicle seat is temporarily removed, verify with the vehicle manufacturer if the seat needs to be recalibrated for proper airbag deployment.
- When drilling into a vehicle structure, be sure that both sides of the surface are clear of anything that could be damaged.
- Refer to the instructions packed with related products for additional precautions and information.
- Do not stare directly into the lights at a close range or permanent damage to your eyesight may occur.
- You should frequently inspect the light system to ensure that it is operating properly and that it is securely attached to the vehicle.
- File these instructions in a safe place and refer to them when maintaining and/or reinstalling the product.

Failure to follow all precautions and instructions may result in property damage, serious injury, or death.

### Introduction

This publication covers the installation of a Federal Signal Spectralux<sup>TM</sup> ILS warning light system in the front headliner of a 2015 Dodge® Durango. The part numbers in these instructions are for vehicle-specific mounting options that are ordered with the product. All mounting systems consist of aluminum shrouds and steel mounting brackets, all of which are powder coated. Mounting hardware is included with each kit.

**NOTE:** For electrical installation instructions, refer to the installation instructions included with the lights.

### **Unpacking the Kit**

After unpacking the kit, inspect it for damage that may have occurred in transit. If it has been damaged, do not attempt to install or operate it. File a claim immediately with the carrier, stating the extent of damage. Carefully check all envelopes, shipping labels, and tags before removing or destroying them. Disposal of all shipping materials must be carried out in accordance with national and local codes and standards. Ensure that the parts listed in the Kit Contents List are included in the package. #### **Installing the Mounting Brackets**

# **A** WARNING

AIRBAG DEPLOYMENT: Do not install equipment or route wiring in the deployment of an airbag. Failure to observe this warning will reduce the effectiveness of the airbag or potentially dislodge the equipment, causing serious injury or death.

DRILLING PRECAUTIONS: Before drilling holes, check the area into which you plan to drill to ensure you do not damage vehicle components while drilling. All drilled holes should be de-burred and all sharp edges should be smoothed. All wires going through drilled holes should be protected by a grommet or convolute/split-loom tubing.

**IMPORTANT:** Plan all cable routing before completing the installation. For wiring instructions, refer to instruction sheet 25500021.

To mount the ILS lightbar:




Figure 1 ILS installed with mounting system on passenger-side

- 1. See Figure 1 on page 3. Install the extruded-rubber sealing strip on the edges of the shroud(s) that contact the windshield. Cut the strip to fit.
- 2. Per the manufacturer's service procedure, remove the sun visor(s) and the sun-visor clip(s)
- **3.** Place the outer brackets on the back of the sun-visor pivot(s). Start reinstalling the sun visor by loosely tightening the screws that secure the pivot(s) in the vehicle.
- **4.** Place the inner brackets on the back of the sun-visor clip(s). Start reinstalling the clip(s) by loosely tightening the screws that secure them in the vehicle.
- 5. Loosely attach the brackets to the shroud with the 1/4"-20 screws and external tooth lockwashers.
- **6.** Ensure the shroud is tight against the windshield and headliner. The sealing strip may require additional trimming. Tighten all hardware.
