Version 3.3.0.0 of the Convergence Network Configuration software is available today to download. This new version replaces the current version 3.2.0.0. The following new features have been added to the software:

- Reconfigured splash screen
- Default configuration file clear/overwrite implemented
- Filter/search option for flash patterns and vehicles added

- PA300-100 amp no longer supports all keypads
- 24-Channel Expansion Module now displays the correct intensity percentage in the configuration viewer
- Screen now maximizes on launch
- Relay wiring report now includes additional columns for upfit wire color and product wire color

- Updated default configuration for PW100 and PA300-100
- Users can now edit the customer-defined relay report fields and print within the software
