**Federal Signal is proud to announce that 2026 is the 75th anniversary of the Q-Siren®.**

In honor of the 75th anniversary, Federal Signal will be introducing a limited edition 75th anniversary emblem that will be incorporated on our various Q-Siren models throughout the remainder of 2026.

The Federal Signal Q-Siren was introduced in 1951 by Federal Sign & Signal Corporation (later Federal Signal Corporation). The Siren was intended to provide a powerful, unmistakable warning sound that would cut through urban noise and clear traffic for emergency vehicles. As the Q-tone® became more recognizable to both pedestrians and drivers, the Q-siren quickly became standard on fire apparatus.

The sound of the Q-Siren became so recognizable over the years, that in 2003 the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) granted Federal Signal a trademark on the sound of the Q-Siren.
